

Glastir Common Land Development Officers

18 vacancies throughout Wales

Common Land Development Officers are required in all parts of Wales to assist with the delivery of Glastir, the new Sustainable Land Management Scheme for Wales funded by the Welsh Assembly Government through the EU's Rural Development Plan. Common land has been identified as an important component of Glastir, pursuing public benefit in environmental improvement and the management of biodiversity.

Eighteen Common Land Development Officers are to be appointed and applications are invited for these posts, which are being overseen by three Local Action Groups; Menter Mon, Cadwyn Clwyd and PLANED.

These posts are of two years duration. Appointed officers will be home based and expected to cover an area equivalent to one or more local authority areas according to the total area of common land present.

Project Officers will be administered as three teams and will be expected to support members of existing Grazier/Commons Associations, or to establish new groups where appropriate, in order to facilitate entry into Glastir provisions.

We are looking for able, well motivated, preferably bilingual communicators and negotiators with an awareness of countryside matters and good administrative skills.
